# **Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2009**

Dear Friends of OAR of Fairfax County,

This past fiscal year (July 1, 2008-June 30, 2009) will be remembered as a time of difficult adjustments for many non-profits. OAR of Fairfax County was no exception.

The fiscal year ahead will also be filled with financial challenges.

However, I am confident that the steps taken this past fiscal year to strengthen and stabilize our budget will enable OAR able to maintain its core services without sacrificing quality.

In FY 2008's report we said we would be watchful for opportunities where we could obtain support either through grants, monetary donations, or in-kind contributions or services.

We followed this approach with these results:

- \$30,000 in new grants from three new funding sources
- Individual holiday giving more than doubled compared to holiday donations in FY 2008
- In-kind contributions rose 50% as compared to the prior fiscal year

This was possible because of the valiant efforts of our board, volunteers, and staff who helped us weather all the storms, financial and otherwise, throughout FY 2009. Armed with the knowledge that we have so many talented, dedicated, and loyal people on our side, we are more than ready to welcome FY 2010. We believe nonprofit organizations can best serve their mission and communities by focusing on their core missions and acting with ethical leadership. That is what we have been doing and will continue to do at OAR of Fairfax County.

- 3,293, total number of clients served
- Community service: 743 placements; savings of \$540,495 in deferred jail costs
- 128 volunteers contributed 8,684 hours, a 38% from FY 2008, valued at \$178,283
- Skills classes: 1,344 participants
- Employment services: 537 clients
- Mentoring clients: 56
- Family outreach (jail lobby): 1,342 service units
- Violence Intervention Classes: 139 participants with 83% success rate
- Impact of Crime class: 127 participants
- 214 homeless clients assisted with housing
- The Beacon program added three new participants; recidivism was 0%


